ORDINANCE NO. 2008-8

**REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-60
AND AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR
PURCHASE OF A DUMP TRUCK AND PICK UP TRUCK**

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2007, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 2007-60, awarding a contract to Ourisman Ford for the purchase of a dump truck and a pick up truck for the Public Works Department; and,

WHEREAS, the City was subsequently notified that Ourisman Ford was ceasing operation and that the contract for the truck purchases would be honored by Lindsay Ford with no change in pricing; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2007-60 must be repealed and a new Ordinance adopted, naming the correct supplier of the vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2007-60 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract in the amount of SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$75,650) with Lindsay Ford for the purchase of a F250 pick up truck and plow and a F450 dump truck with plow and salt spreader.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
